- The school will re-open after the summer break on Monday, **12 June 2023** for grades Nur to IX. timings will be 8:40 am to 12:45 pm on 12-06-2023 and will be 8:40 am to 3:30 pm from 13 June 2023 onwards. Attendance from the first working day is mandatory.
- The office will function on all working days from **9:30** am to **1:00** pm during summer vacation.

Every new generation is said to be born with a little extra brain capacity and their exposure to gadgets at a tender age is a challenge for both parents and teachers to keep their focus on constructive learning and skill development. Especially with vacations around, keeping them close to ground reality is a task for the parents. We have a few suggestions for keeping them positively engaged: -

- 1- A fixed time of getting up every day should be inculcated.
- 2- At least one hour of physical activity like skipping, running, jogging or some sport can be encouraged.
- 3- Have at least two meals together and encourage healthy eating habits like more protein, fruits and vegetables in the diet.
- 4- Encourage them to wash their plates and undergarments. They learn the dignity of labour.
- 5- 4-5 hours of learning must continue in holidays it could be academic subjects, a new skill, music/dance or a new language, or a mixture of all. Reading a book would be a good practice.
- 6- Limited and monitored time on gadgets is a must.
- 7- Allow your child to help you with cooking or other chores at least once a day.
- 8- They should visit their grandparents / extended family to understand the importance of family. Ask them to draw a 'Family Tree' on chart paper.
- 9- Plan a visit to some orphanage or old age home to develop empathy for fellow citizens.
- 10- Ask them to grow some plants and take care of them regularly.
